2. DISCOUNTS ON TUITION FEES FOR FAMILIES

- For families with 2 or more children at the school, **10**% off the fees amount for each child for the whole duration of their studies.
- A further discount of 5% will be offered on tuition fees only, when these are paid in advance for the entire year, on the date of registration.
- Xenion Institute students who have siblings at Xenion High School receive a 10% discount on Institute fees every year.
 - o All discounts will remain in force even after the graduation of older children in the family.

3. ALUMNI HONORARY CONCESSION

5% on tuition fees for all 6 years of study to the 1st child of the family when at least one parent has studied and graduated from Xenion High School.

4. REGISTRATION FEE

- Admission Fee (Payable by new students only in any year): €200
- Annual Registration Fee (Compulsory for continuing pupils): €75

5. MISCELLANEOUS CHARGES

- Entrance Exams Fee: €100.00
- Composite Fee (Art/Laboratories/Computing and other facilities): €150.00 payable annually in advance.
- External Exams: Any external exam fees are not included in the tuition fees.
- **Trips & other special projects**: Students will be charged separately before trips and other educational visits take place.
- School Uniform and Books: Available from and payable at the school Bookshop.

8. REVISED TUITION FEES

The school has the right to revise tuition fees, without prior notice.

Any possible increment on fees has a cap of 5% per year.

9. REFUNDS

Fees, Books and Uniform purchases paid to the school are non-refundable and non-exchangeable.

NOTES:

- Registration for the next school year is subject to full settlement of all outstanding tuition and/or other fees. The deposit payment for each student re-enrollment is included in the cost of tuition fees.
- 2. The school has the right to withdraw scholarships, monetary prizes, or discounts in case of overdue fees or serious disciplinary incident.
- 3. Additional fees may be applied for any supplementary courses.
- 4. Progress reports and / or other certificates will not be issued if fees or other charges are overdue.
- 5. For students who are entitled to any grands or subsidies by the Cyprus Government or any other organisation or authority, it is the obligation of the parents/guardians to settle the school fees in full irrespective of when the subsidy is received.
- 6. Please note that students cannot be insured after the 1^{st} of September if the Parents Association fee is not paid upon registration.
- 7. In the event of a student, for any reason, leaving the school before the end of the academic year, their tuition fees must be settled in full.
- 8. The inability to continue with school lessons, for whatever reason, does not exempt the parent/guardian/pupil from the obligation to pay the school fees for the whole academic year. Any balance of fees due upon the departure of a student from the school, irrespective of the date of departure, must be paid in full. In the event that fees of a student were paid in full, and the student ceases to attend the school, no refund is applicable.
- 9. Books and Uniform purchases paid to the school are non-refundable.
